**Dec. 14**—Camp Rilea, Warrenton (drive-thru)

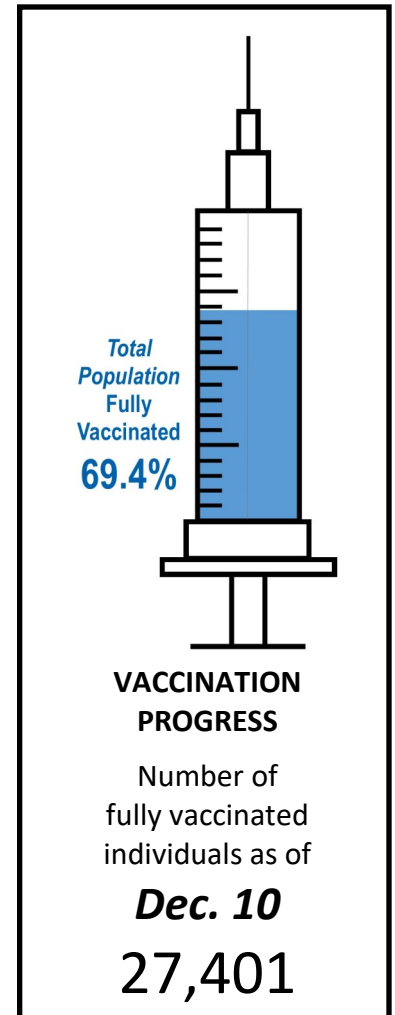

### **VACCINATION PROGRESS**

Clatsop County has reached **79.6%** of its population 18 years and older with at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine

Our goal is **80%** – Clatsop County is **7th** in Oregon nearing this goal, with **141** people remaining to be vaccinated.

19% of 5-to-11-year-olds have received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine; 9% have completed the two-dose series.

### OUTBREAKS

Outbreaks—**3** currently under monitoring

*What is an Outbreak?*

Oregon Health Authority defines an outbreak as two or more positive COVID-19 cases with a shared “epi-link” – a place or person in common. In the case of an employee or resident of a congregate residential setting, or food chain or agricultural setting, the outbreak threshold is one positive case. [Read more here.](#)
