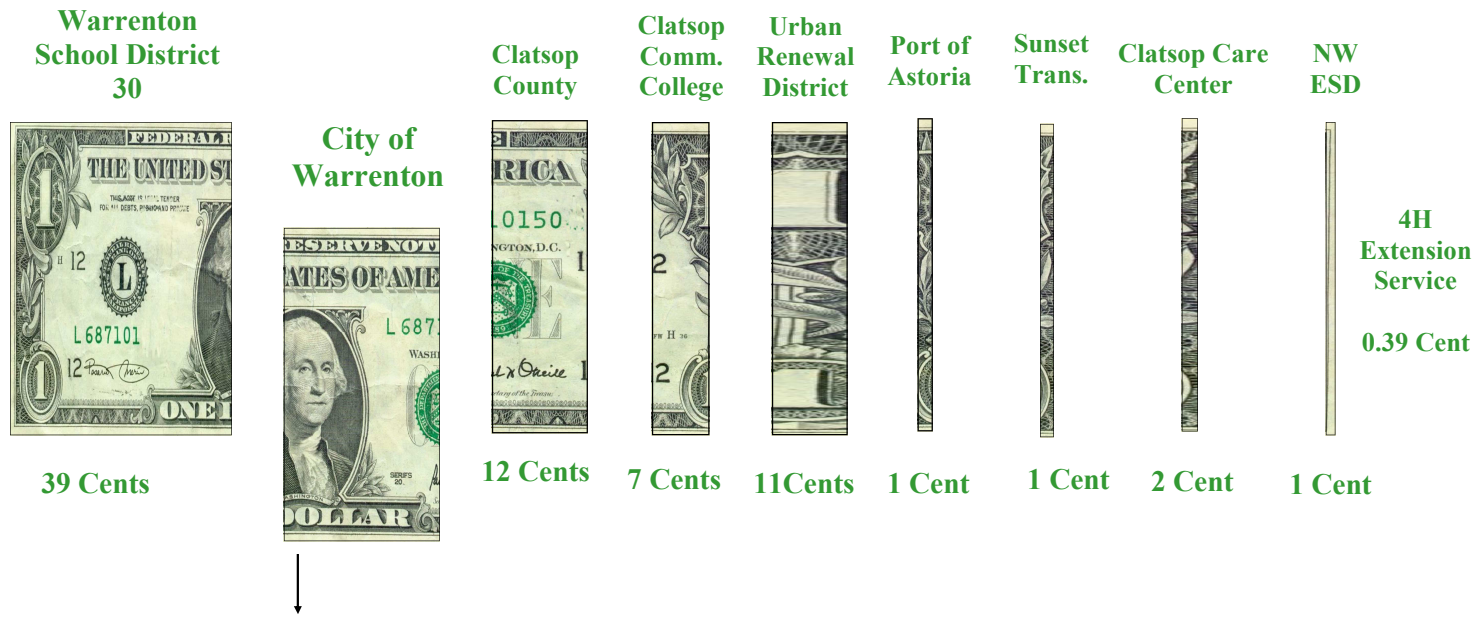


How is *your* property tax dollar spent?

When you write ***your*** property tax check to Clatsop County, only ***some*** of your money goes to the **City of Warrenton**. This illustration shows what a citizen of Warrenton pays for City and County-wide services.



If you live in **tax code 3004 or 3010**, this is what your **25 cents** to City of Warrenton provides:

12 cents
General City Services

Public Safety, Municipal Court, Administration, Planning, and Parks



8 cents
General Obligation Bonds

Waste Water Treatment Plant



3 cents
Library Local Option



2 cents
Police Officer Local Option

Adds one additional officer in Police Department



If you live in **tax code 0113**, this is what your **22 cents** to City of Warrenton provides:

11 cents
General City Services

Public Safety, Municipal Court, Administration, Planning, and Parks



7 cents
General Obligation Bonds

Waste Water Treatment Plant



2 cents
Library Local Option



2 cents
Police Officer Local Option

Adds one additional officer in Police Department



City services your property tax dollars do NOT pay for:

- Warrenton Community Center
- Building codes inspection and enforcement
- Marinas
- Warrenton Business Association
- Streets
- Water, Sewer, Storm Sewer and Garbage Service

These programs funded by user fees, state revenues, grants, and other sources.

The City of Warrenton Permanent Rate Levy is \$1.6701 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. The owner of a home with an assessed value of \$125,000 pays approximately **\$208.76 per year for General City Services**. The local option levies are separate from the permanent rate and are approved by voters for a maximum period of 5 years.
