Request for Bids (RFB): Warrenton Marina Improvements – Pile Replacement

Project Summary

The intent of this contract is to replace 10 steel pilings along the Warrenton Marinas Commercial E Dock and A dock by the vibration method. The following is a brief summary of the major elements of work that are to be provided by the contractor

1. Replace 10 steel pilings; 8 that are 16 inches in diameter and 2 that are 12 inches in diameter.
2. Follow current DSL permit requirements during replacement.

Bids will be publicly opened and read by the Harbormaster at 2:00 PM, local time on October 15, 2025 in the Warrenton Marina Office.

If the total bid exceeds \$50,000.00 the contract will be subject to Prevailing Wage Statute ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870. The contract is NOT subject to federal prevailing wage rates under the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 3141 et seq). Prior to submission of its bid, the bidder shall be registered with the Oregon Construction Contractor's Board as required by ORS 701.055, and thereafter comply with the requirements of ORS 701.035 to 701.055. Bidders shall be qualified in accordance with the applicable parts of ORS 279C in order to submit a bid for public works in Oregon.
