WPD Safety Blitz #3 Enforcement

Warrenton, OR – The Warrenton Police Department will be joining with the other law enforcement agencies in Clatsop County and around the State of Oregon to participate in the **3**rd **Safety Belt Blitz Monday**, **August 24**, **2020 through Sunday**, **September 6**, **2020**. During this timeframe WPD officers will use grant-funded OT hours as well as straight-time enforcement hours to provide enhanced patrols looking for all traffic violation with an emphasis on:

- Child Seats
- Fitting Station Referrals for Child Passenger Safety Week later in September
- Texting & Speed

Distracted-Driving Stats

- ODOT crash data for 2018 shows lack of safety belt or child restraint use was a factor in 28% or 86 of a total 311 motor vehicle occupant fatalities.
- Safety belts used correctly can reduce the risk of major crash injury or death by up to sixty- five percent.
- In 2017 an Oregon law was passed requiring children to ride in a rear-facing safety seat until they are at least two years old. A child over age two must continue to ride in a car seat with harness or in a booster until they reach age eight or 4'9" in height and the adult belt fits them correctly.
- Many car seat fitting stations will host special events during National Child Passenger Safety Week September 20 through 26, with Certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians on-hand to assist families with selection and use of car seats and boosters.

These efforts are done with the goal to increase traffic safety and reduce traffic-related traffic incidents.
