## OFFICER INJURED BY DUIL CRASH SUSPECT

Warrenton, OR – On December 11, 2020 at about 11:19 PM Warrenton Police Officers were dispatched to a reckless driving complaint in the area of NW 13th Place and NW Warrenton Drive. Officers located the involved vehicle, a white Ford F350, on its side in the ditch on NW 13th Place. Officers found the driver, Bailey Enloe, 24 of Astoria, slumped against the driver side window, unresponsive.

Officers and Medix personnel made entry into the vehicle, and Enloe became very combative with Officers and Medix. Enloe continued to assault officers causing injuries to an officer. Officers deployed a Taser to attempt to overcome Enloe's assault and resistance. Enloe was ultimately taken into custody and appeared to be under the influence of intoxicants, so she was transported via Medix to Columbia Memorial Hospital for clearance prior to being transported to the Clatsop County Jail.

A Warrenton Police Officer was riding onboard the ambulance with Medix personnel due to Enloe's custody status and combativeness. During the transport to Columbia Memorial Hospital, Enloe kicked the Officer onboard, causing him to lose consciousness. The ambulance stopped and other officers and deputies secured Enloe. The Officer was transported to Columbia Memorial Hospital in a second Medix ambulance and has been admitted for his injuries.

Enloe was later transported to the Clatsop County Jail and lodged on charges of:

- DUII
- Reckless Driving
- · Assaulting Public Safety Officer
- Assault in the Second Degree
- Resisting Arrest x2
- Interfering with a Police Officer
- Disorderly Conduct in the First Degree

The case will be referred to the Clatsop County District Attorney's Office.
