## GENERAL CONDITIONS

Rules and standards for City of Warrenton Public Right-of-Way are set by Warrenton Municipal Code (WMC) <a href="https://qcode.us/codes/warrenton/">https://qcode.us/codes/warrenton/</a> Chapter 12.32 PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY. It is recommended that you review the WMC before you apply.
Applications for permits to work in the Right-of-Way shall be accompanied by drawings/plans and specifications in sufficient detail to demonstrate that the facilities are to be constructed in accordance with all applicable codes, rules and regulations WMC 12.32.050 E
The permittee shall be responsible for obtaining locates from any affected public or private utilities and shall use all caution with respect to such utilities and shall be responsible for all damages caused by permittee operations. Permittee is required to show how they plan to protect or relocate any existing utilities.
Permittee shall ensure proper signing and traffic control to protect the public. Traffic control equipment and signing should be consistent with Oregon Temporary Traffic Control Handbook published by ODOT. No street will be closed without prior approval from Public Works and a detailed traffic control and public notifications plan.
Permittee will notify Public Works <b>48 business hours</b> prior to start of construction and/or required inspection.
The permit is void 120 days from date of issue.
A performance surety is required. This may be a bond or other surety acceptable to the City equal to at least 100% of the estimated cost of work. Performance surety will remain in effect for 60 days past project completion.
Permittee shall provide as-built drawings to the City for any construction or facilities in the public Right-of-Way or easement before permit can be closed and performance surety released.
This permit shall be issued only to a duly licensed and bonded contractor holding a current City of Warrenton business license with proof of liability and workers compensation insurance, except a property owner who is not a license contractor and meets the requirement of the code. WMC 12.32 C.
Permittee is responsible for correction work including and not limited to removal, disposal, or replacement of unsatisfactory work.
ATTENTION: Oregon law requires you to follow rules adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification Center. Those rules are set forth in OAR 952-001-0010 through OAR 952-001-0100.
