Curbside Exemption

The City of Warrenton's curbside exemption program provides special service at no additional cost to residents who are physically unable to place their garbage and recycle carts curbside for collection.

If approved, applications are valid from July 1 to June 30 each year.

Customers are eligible only if they comply with both Part I and Part II.

Part I

Eligible customers must provide one of the following:

1. A letter of verification from a licensed physician stating that you are physically unable to place the cart curbside or roadside for collection.

OR

2. A copy of your driver's license denoting handicapped status.

OR

3. A copy of your handicapped placard paperwork from the Oregon Department of Motor Vehicles.

Part II

Eligible customers must also provide confirmation that no occupant of the premises is physically able to place carts curbside or roadside for collection.

Please complete the application on the reverse side and attach the required information in Part I. Applications may be turned in by mail or in person.
